- 3/ Items donated to the Danish Museum in Dickson are 3rd Priority.

4/ The members of the club can only add their name to a maximum of 2 items, if other members are interested in the same item, they will be added up to a maximum of 3 names.

If the above should happen, then the Heritage Committee will decide by drawing names. That decision will be final.
